Subject:	Firehall Bridge in Millbrook Municipal Class EA and Decorative	
	Railings	

Recommendations:

- 1. That Council receive Public Works Report No. 2022-03 Firehall Bridge Millbrook Municipal Class EA and Decorative Railings for information; and
- 2. That Council approve the cost sharing of decorative railings with Peterborough County up to \$40,000 to be funded through the Federal Tax Grant Reserve.

Overview:

Peterborough County is preparing for the rehabilitation of the Firehall Bridge in 2022 which includes a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) process for the bridge located on King Street East (County Road 21) in the settlement area of Millbrook in the spring of 2022 (Attachment No. 1, Notice to Public). The project is classed as a Schedule A+ project under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process and is pre-approved to proceed. Public consultation process will be managed by the County of Peterborough, the Notice to the Public that will be distributed to adjacent property owners and a project signboard that will be posted at the site. The bridge requires rehabilitation with the County to complete the full works necessary. Proposed timelines for the construction includes a tentative start date of June 1, 2022 with completion anticipated by October 31, 2022.

Township staff suggested that this bridge should include decorative railings and design to match the Baxter Creek Bridge on Needlers Lane. Township Staff met with County Staff and have proposed cost sharing of 50 % for the decorative railings. The recommended allowance for the Township's share of the decorative railing cost is \$40,000 as noted in the cost estimate provided by the County (Attachment No. 2, Decorative Railings Cost Estimate).

Due to the nature of the proposed rehabilitation works, single lane traffic will be required with a single light for this section of King Street East for the duration of the works, which has a tentative start date of June 1, 2022 – October 31, 2022 (Attachment No. 3, Draft Traffic Staging Plan).

Township Staff have advised the Business Improvement Area of the Firehall rehabilitation and asked the BIA for confirmation on the scheduled planed event dates so that when the tender is issued the event dates are identified within the document to ensure cooperation.

Financial Impact:

The Finance Director has suggested that the Township's portion of the cost for the decorative design and railings of \$40,000 (50% by the Township and the County) be funded through the Federal Tax Grant Reserve.

Notice to Public County of Peterborough Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Rehabilitation of Firehall Bridge in Millbrook

The County of Peterborough is preparing for the rehabilitation of Firehall Bridge in 2022, located on County Road (CR) 21 (King Street East) in the settlement area of Millbrook. Following the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process as a Schedule A+ undertaking, public input is invited for incorporation into the planning and design of the project.



The projected timelines for construction includes a **tentative start date of June 1, 2022**, **with completion anticipated by October 31, 2022**, subject to weather constraints and other factors.
